

PEGs - Jumpstart Checklist

Follow the steps below to start planning for PEG 2 and PEG 3!

STEP 1: Get familiar with PEG Requirements and Resources

- ☐ Log into [GivePulse](#) using your WWC email and password

STEP 2: Have you already had experiences that could qualify for PEG 2 or PEG 3?

Sometimes, students have already completed a PEG without realizing it!

- ☐ For PEG 2:
 - Have you taken a designated PEG 2 course?
 - Have you volunteered during a school break or regularly volunteered with the same organization while a WWC student?
 - Have you had community engagement experiences through your WWC Work Crew or athletic team?
- ☐ For PEG 3:
 - Have you completed an internship (or are you planning to apply for one?) with a nonprofit organization or an organization that serves the community/environment?
 - Are you planning a Capstone Project or NSRS that could partner with a community or governmental organization?
 - Have you led other students in community engagement activities?

STEP 3: Brainstorm - What do YOU want to do?

- ☐ Have you had community engagement experiences in the past that you enjoyed? What kind of work did you do? Why did you enjoy it?
- ☐ Are there any specific social/environmental issues that you care about?
- ☐ Have you researched community partners in the area (or elsewhere!) that you'd like to work with?

 - Google searches can be helpful too! Most nonprofit websites have a volunteer/how to get involved page.
