

PEG 3 CRITERIA

Students complete a signature community engagement experience by working toward a specific goal in collaboration with an off-campus community partner.

PEG 3 should be completed by the end of a student's junior year. If a student plans to complete a community-engaged senior capstone project that will fulfill PEG 3, they should submit their PEG 3 proposal by the end of their junior year.

Community Partner	 Community partners must meet at least one of the following criteria: Nonprofit or government organization School or Educational Institution Grassroots community organization Community-focused program within a for-profit organization
Type of Engagement	PEG 3 can be completed through: Independent, 50-hour PEG 3 experience Community-Engaged Academic Senior Capstone Project Leadership of an Understand (PEG 2) opportunity (i.e., designated work crew or break trip) Designated Community-Engaged PEG 3 Course
Nature of Project	Students should collaborate with their community partner to identify a project that will further the mission of the program or organization and benefits the community outside of Warren Wilson College. Projects could include, but are not limited to: • Direct support for ongoing programs • Capacity building or fundraising projects • Communications or event planning support • Research or writing projects • Advocacy or policy-related projects
Hours Minimum	PEG 3 requires a minimum of 50 hours (this can be direct or indirect hours). *Travel time to and from the community partner does not count toward the 50 hour minimum.
Required PEG 3 Proposal	Students must submit a PEG 3 proposal for approval prior to beginning the PEG 3 project.
PEG 3 Impact & Reflection Questions	At conclusion of PEG 3 project, students must: Submit hours as an Impact on GivePulse Complete required PEG 3 reflection questions included on Impact form
Hours Verification	PEG 3 hours must be verified by the community partner. This can be done through: • Providing verifier name and email address on PEG 3 Impact form linked above • Written verification from community partner of hours completed. These must be emailed directly to engagement@warren-wilson.edu.
