Welcome to Warren Wilson College!

Approximately 30 percent of our incoming class will be selected by the Department of Education to have the details provided on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) verified. This process is required to be completed before the college can release your financial aid.

To assist this process, Warren Wilson College has procured KHEEA Verify to conduct FAFSA verifications on our behalf.

KHEAA (the Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority) is a not-for-profit state agency that administers state grants, scholarships and private loans for Kentucky. It also offers several third-party services to assist colleges and universities with specific processes.

Should your FAFSA be selected for verification, KHEAA staff will contact you to let you know what is needed to complete the verification process. Please provide the necessary documentation to KHEAA as quickly as possible.

Helpful Hints

- If you're a tax filer:
Use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool which will populate FAFSA's tax return questions.
— OR —
Submit an IRS tax transcript if you do not, or cannot, use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool. Request a transcript at www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript or call 855-272-8771.
- If you're not required to file taxes, submit a copy of all your W-2's to document earnings.
- Login to your FAFSA at <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa> at a later time if you need to make a correction or update your tax information.
- Complete all requested forms.
- Answer all questions, even if it is a "0."
- Provide all required signatures.
- Based on the documentation received, you may be required to submit additional information.
