Statement of Electronic Process and Electronic Consent from Students

By logging into and accessing financial aid records on their Net Partner account, students agree and specifically consent to the use of electronic records. Specifically, the electronic processes to which they are consenting include (but are not limited to):

- Electronic funds transfer of loan funds to their student account
- Use of electronic mail to provide notice that any loan from the direct loan program has been disbursed to their account
- Use of electronic mail to notify of award notification(s)
- Use of electronic mail to notify them that additional information must be submitted to the Financial Aid Office and the use of Net Partner to access additional documentation requests
- Access to student consumer information at warren-wilson.edu/finaid
- Electronic mail to exchange information concerning your financial aid records

Students may rescind this authorization at any time and/or request paper copies of any information communicated electronically by contacting the Financial Aid Office at Warren Willson College at 828.771.2082, by email at finaid@warren-wilson.edu, or in person at the Financial Aid Office (first floor of Laursen Building).

Students also authorize the financial aid staff to obtain information concerning your educational program and financial circumstances as needed to process your application and you authorize the release of information, including need analysis data and the amount of any award(s) to agencies, individuals, or organizations involved in providing funds for your education.

Students understand that they are responsible for all charges, including any initially covered by financial aid. If upon review of supporting items, it is determined that the student is not eligible for financial aid or if the student is not eligible for the amounts originally estimated, the student will be responsible for any balance due if financial aid awards are adjusted due to these changes.

Students also understand and agree that they must report any changes in financial circumstances, enrollment status, or additional financial aid to the Financial Aid Office. They also agree to comply with all institutional policies as well as federal and state regulations. They also understand that reported changes may result in revisions to your aid offer. Students understand that the college may withhold or cancel financial aid if any of the requested information is not submitted or presents a conflict of information.
